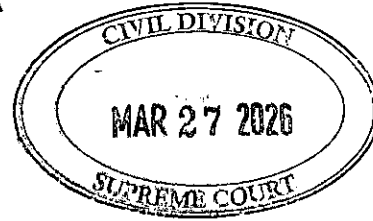

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


1. In accordance with section 14 (10) (a) of the Terrorism Prevention Act.
2. **QDi.437 Name: 1: SAMI 2: JASIM 3: MUHAMMAD JAATA 4: AL-JABURI A.K.A.: A) MUSTAFA ADNAN AL-AZIZ and QDi. 438 Name: 1 ABD EL HAMID 2: SALIM 3: IBRAHIM BRUKAN 4: AL-KHATOUNI A.K.A.: ABU OMAR AL SARRAF** designated as terrorist entity by the United Nations Security Council and whose information were added to the United Nations Sanctions List under Reference Number SC/16323 AND SC/16324 dated March 26, 2026 and are hereby declared as listed entities for the purposes of the Terrorism Prevention Act:
3. In accordance with section 6 (1) of the **Terrorism Prevention Act**, no person in Jamaica or no Jamaican in or outside of Jamaica shall knowingly:
 - a. deal directly or indirectly with any property that is owned or controlled by or on behalf of the above listed individual/entity.
 - b. enter into or facilitate, directly or indirectly, any transactions in respect of that property that is owned or controlled by on behalf of the above-mentioned listed individual/entity.
 - c. provide any financial or related services in respect of that property that is owned or controlled by or on behalf of the above-mentioned listed individual/entity.
 - d. Convert any property owned or controlled by or on behalf of the below mentioned entities or take any steps to conceal or disguise that property is owned or controlled by or on behalf of the above-mentioned listed individual/entity.

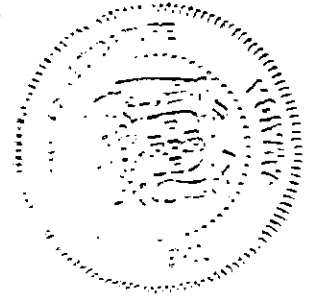
4. This Order relates to:
