 - c. This Order relates to the following entity whose details are contained in UN document SCA/2/21 (14) dated September 6, 2021: QDi.253 Name: 1: KHALIFA 2: MUHAMMAD 3: TURKI 4: AL-SUBAIY
- 2. The Applicant's attorney is to prepare, file and serve a copy of this Order along with a copy of UN document SCA/2/21 (14) dated September 6, 2021, issued by the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List Committee on all relevant authority and financial institutions.
